WHAT IS DOCUMENT SHREDDING?

Document shredding is the secure destruction of sensitive and confidential paper materials like bank statements and pay stubs.

IS SHREDDED PAPER RECYCLED?

DSWA contracts professional document destruction companies to securely handle your documents. On-site shredding occurs during document shredding events. 100% of the shredded paper is then recycled at a paper mill.

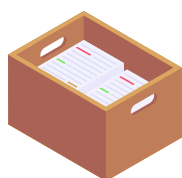


WHY CAN'T SHREDDED PAPER GO INTO MY RECYCLE BIN?

At recycling centers, paper is sorted by its 2 dimensional, flat shape. Shredding paper distorts its original shape and it can no longer be recognized by sorting machines. Shredded paper tangles in machines and makes a mess inside recycle trucks. Any shredded paper put into a recycle bin will be discarded as trash.

IS THERE A LIMIT I CAN BRING?

Shredding is an extremely popular service! DSWA allows 2 full sized boxes of paper per person at each event.



A TIP FOR SAFE SHREDDING

Please always check your boxes before bringing them! Non-paper items can get stuck in shredding trucks and batteries can cause fires.
