What Is Yard Waste?

Yard waste is plant material that comes from lawn maintenance and other gardening and landscaping activities.

Since 2007, Delaware Code has prohibited residents from combining yard waste with household garbage.

Drop-Off Instructions

Yard waste must be separated from trash and placed loose and unbagged in the designated yard waste drop-off area.

Accepted as Yard Waste

- Grass Clippings
- Prunings
- Brush and Shrubbery
- Christmas Trees
- Tree Limbs up to 4 inches in diameter

Accepted as Trash

- Tree limbs over 4 inches in diameter
- Stumps
- Pet/Animal Waste
- Wood or Treated Lumber
- Outdoor Furniture
- Flower Pots
- Construction Debris
- Dirt/Soil and Mulch
- Painted wood
